## **Homecoming Campus Safety**

Fayetteville State University is committed to providing a safe environment for the entire campus community. As we prepare for a week of spirited Homecoming events, celebrations, and reunions, the Office of Risk and Compliance reminds all members of our campus community students, faculty, staff, and guests to prioritize safety, respect, and responsibility in all activities. Please review the following Homecoming Safety Tips to ensure that this year's festivities are both fun and safe for everyone.

## **Title IX Awareness**

- Title IX protects against sexual harassment, assault, stalking, and relationship violence.
- Consent must be clear, informed, and voluntary.
- If you or someone you know experiences misconduct, support is available, and reports can be made confidentially or anonymously.

## **Construction Awareness & Safety**

- Follow all posted signage and stay out of restricted areas.
- Do not cross barricades or move temporary fencing.
- Be extra cautious around heavy equipment, trucks, and rerouted walkways.
- Allow extra travel time between events to avoid blocked areas.
