Automated External Defibrillators

As part of Fayetteville State University's ongoing commitment to maintaining a safe and prepared campus environment, we are pleased to announce the installation of new Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) in campus facilities. The new Avive devices feature advanced, connected technology that helps dramatically reduce emergency response times and improve lifesaving outcomes during cardiac emergencies.

- **Increased Accessibility:** Building will be equipped with a minimum of **two AED units**, strategically placed to ensure quick access during emergencies and reduce response time.
- **Advanced Technology:** The new AEDs offer enhanced functionality, including clear step-by-step audio and visual guidance, real-time monitoring, and faster deployment to support responders of all experience levels in both English and Spanish.
- **Improved Readiness:** These devices are designed to self-monitor and report readiness status, helping ensure they are always operational when needed.
- **Adult/Adolescent Compatibility:** The new Avive AEDs do not require child pads when addressing cardiac arrest but instead utilize a child button.

All employees are encouraged to familiarize themselves with the locations of AED units within their respective buildings. Hands-on training sessions and informational resources will be scheduled and shared soon to ensure employees feel confident and prepared to use the new AEDs in the event of an emergency.
