8.2. GEN ED: Addl . Choose courses classified as general education under the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement. May include additional UGETC courses.

9.1. Criminal Justice. CRJC 200 And CRJC 201 And CRJC 215 And CRJC 220 And CRJC 304 And CRJC 314 And CRJC 450 .

9.11. Pre-Maj/Elect Major courses that can be taken at the community college.

9.2. Criminal Justice Elective. Select nine from the following: Any CRJC course not otherwise used to satisfy core or major requirements; Or one of the following approved, non-CRJC courses: ENGL 380, GEOG 320, 200-level language course, or SOCI 333. .

9.3. Other Required. PSYC 210 And SOCI 210 And one additional three hour course from ECON, GEOG, INTL, HIST, HIPO, POLI, PSYC, or SOCI. POLI 210 does not meet this requirement if taken to fulfill core requirements. .

9.4. Statistics Elective. CRJC 315 Or POLI 240 Or PSYC 233 Or SOCI 331 .
