- \* Recommended. For transfer courses, following recommendations will reduce or eliminate the need to take additional courses at FSU. For FSU courses, following recommendations will optimize the student's educational experience. If in doubt, consult an advisor.
- 1.1. Core Transitional UNIV.** (UNIV 101 And UNIV 102) Or UNIV 110 Or UNIV 111. UNIV 101-UNIV 102 required for all first time students; UNIV 110 required for transfer students with fewer than 30 transfer credits. Students do not earn credit if requirement is waived. UNIV 111 may be required based on academic performance.
  - 1.2. Core Transitional Life.** HEED 112.
  - 2.1. Core Written Comm.** ENGL 110.
  - 2.2. Core Oral Comm.** SPEE 200.
  - 3.1. Core Critical Thinking.** PHIL 110 Or PHIL 220. Not required for students with 60+ transfer credits. Students do not earn credit if requirement is waived.
  - 3.2. Core Quantitative Reason.** MATH 123. MATH 121 may be required based on profile scores. Some core courses require a one-hour lab.
  - 4. Core Info Literacy.** ENGL 120.
  - 5.1. Core Natural Sci.** NSCI 110 Or NSCI 111 And NSCI 111L And NSCI 120.
  - 5.2. Core Social Sci.** POLI 210 Or POLI 220 Or SOCI 210.
  - 6. Core Humn Creative Arts.** HUMN 211 Or HUMN 212.
  - 7. Core Global Literacy.** HIST 110 Or HIST 120. Not required for students with 30+ transfer credits from a foreign institution. Students do not earn credit if requirement is waived.
  - 8. Core Ethics Civic Engage.** EDUC 211. Not required for students with 60+ transfer credits. Students do not earn credit if requirement is waived.
  - 9.1. Professional Education.** EDUC 210 And EDUC 211 And EDUC 310 And EDUC 330 And EDUC 331 And ENGL 300 And ELEM 471 And ELEM 491 And SPED 320.
  - 9.2. Elem Ed Major Core.** ELEM 320 And ELEM 335 And ELEM 400 And ELEM 401 And ELEM 402 And HIST 211 Or HIST 212 Formal admission to Teacher Education required to enroll in ELEM 400, ELEM 401, ELEM 402.
  - 9.3. Math Concentration.** Select 18 hours from the following courses: MATH 131 (MATH 121, 129, 130 may be required; MATH 129-130 with C in each substitutes for MATH 131.) And MATH 142 And MATH 241 And MATH 242 And MATH 251 And MATH 262 And STAT 202.
  - 9.4. Major Elective.** PEDU 101 Or PEDU 107 Or PEDU 112 Or PEDU 120 Or PEDU 122 Or PEDU 130 Or PEDU 132 Or PEDU 140 And MATH elective.
  - 9.5. Other Major.** PSYC 210.
  - 9.6. Restricted Electives.** ELEM 451.
