Reported Crime: Fayetteville Police Department Vehicle Pursuit

Notice is being provided to the campus community of an incident involving a vehicle pursuit by the Fayetteville Police Department resulting in a motor vehicle collision.

The collision occurred on Murchison Road near Lot N behind Seabrook Auditorium. The suspects involved were arrested by Fayetteville Police Department officers, shortly after they ran from the wrecked vehicle.
