Off-Campus Community Safety Advisory - July 17, 2018

Reported Crime: Homicide, City of Fayetteville - Off Campus

Location: 1600 block of Slater Avenue

The Fayetteville Police Departments responded to a report of shots fired at the 1600 block of Slater Avenue at about 9:48 p.m. July 16, 2018. An unknown suspect shot and killed one female victim. The suspects then fled the area, it is unknown in the direction. Fayetteville Police Department has advised that this incident was not a random act and was target specific to the victim, per their investigation. Further information is unknown at this time. Fayetteville State University Police Department is assisting local law enforcement officers in the investigation.
