Notice is being provided to the campus community in regard to a crime that occurred at (Seabrook Park) 708 Langdon St. today.

On 09/15/2024 at approximately 9:30 p.m., an armed robbery was reported to Fayetteville State University Police and Public Safety. Officers responded and spoke with several victims. The victims reported three male suspects brandished firearms and demanded valuables from them. One suspect is stated to have asked to use one of the victims' cellular phones at which time another two suspects arrived at Seabrook Park and robbed all victims at gunpoint. Three suspects listed below then departed on foot East on Langdon St. toward Ramsey St. Fayetteville Police Department along with Fayetteville State University Police and Public Safety are investigating this crime.

There are no major injuries reported.

The three suspects were described as follows:

Black male, light complexion, approximately 5'7", wearing a pink medical face mask armed with a black in color handgun with a light attached.

Black male, medium complexion, approximately 5'5", wearing a teal in color medical face mask armed with a Mini AK style rifle.

Black male, light complexion with dreads and a beard, approximately 6'2", wearing a blue shirt, grey sweatpants and red and white shoes.

- •To protect yourself and others in our community
- •To notify you that there may be a threat to the campus or near the campus
- •To help with the investigation of possible crimes

Fayetteville State University Police Department and Fayetteville Police Department continue to investigate this incident.
