Notice is being provided to the campus community of an alleged crime reported to have occurred across the street from Fayetteville State University Campus. We are sending this message for you:

- To protect yourself and others in our community
- To notify you that there may be a threat to the campus
- To help with the investigation of possible crimes

On March 27, 2020 at 12:35 am the Fayetteville State University Department of Police and Public Safety was notified of an alleged incident. Fayetteville Police Department responded to the Day N Night Food Mart located across the street from the campus of Fayetteville State University after receiving a call that an unknown person had been shot and was laying on the outside property of the store. An unknown suspect wearing dark clothes fled the scene in a dark colored van towards Cumberland Street away from campus.

It is believed that no one involved in this incident is associated with Fayetteville State University.

Suspect: Unknown black male wearing dark colored clothing
