- CJC 111, 121, 132, 141, PSY 150, and SOC 210 are prerequisites for upper-level CRJC required courses and should be taken as early as possible and prioritized in scheduling.
- If a student chooses a minor, plan schedules so that any prerequisites and/or rarely offered courses are taken as early as possible.
- The Foundations in American Democracy requirement can be met by taking a course from one of the following University Core Curriculum categories: Written Communication, Ethics and Civic Engagement, Social Science Literacy, and Humanities and Creative Arts. See Guide for the list of courses.

Other Program Requirements

- 1 A minimum overall GPA of 2.0 and a final grade of "C" or higher is required to declare Criminal Justice as a major. All University College Core Curriculum courses must be fully completed before acceptance to the online degree completion (ODC) program.
- 2 Grade of C or higher in all major courses, including any non-criminal justice courses used to meet the criminal justice elective, other required courses, or statistics elective major requirements. An overall GPA of 2.00 or higher is required to graduate.
- 3 No academic credit is awarded for life experiences or for military, police academy, or other professional training.
- 4 Criminal Justice majors must earn at least 50% of their credits in criminal justice through instruction offered by the institution.

- 3 No academic credit is awarded for life experiences or for military, police academy, or other professional training.
- 4 Criminal Justice majors must earn at least 50% of their credits in criminal justice through instruction offered by the institution.
