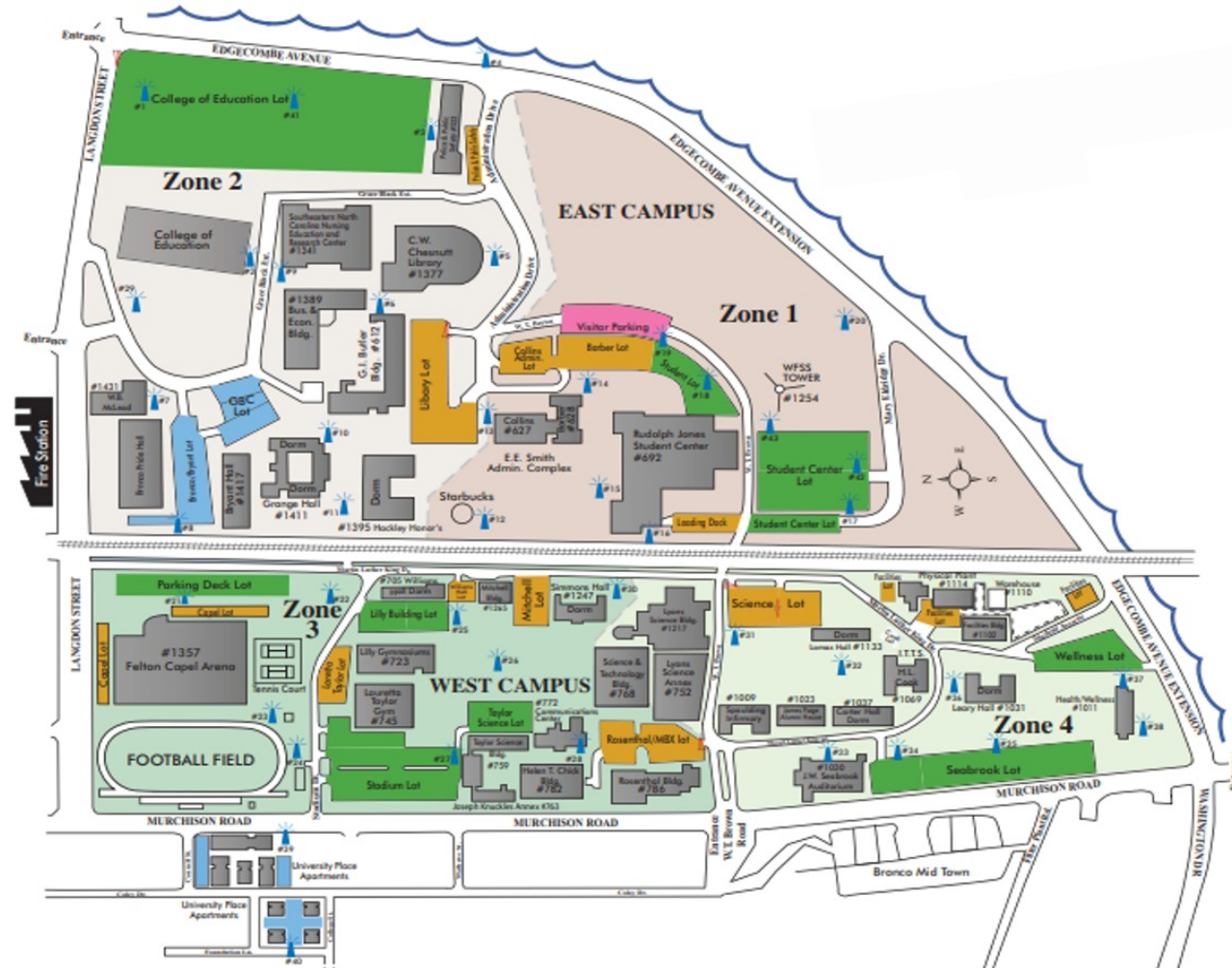
- At express check-in, you will receive a one-day parking decal as you transition to the residence hall.

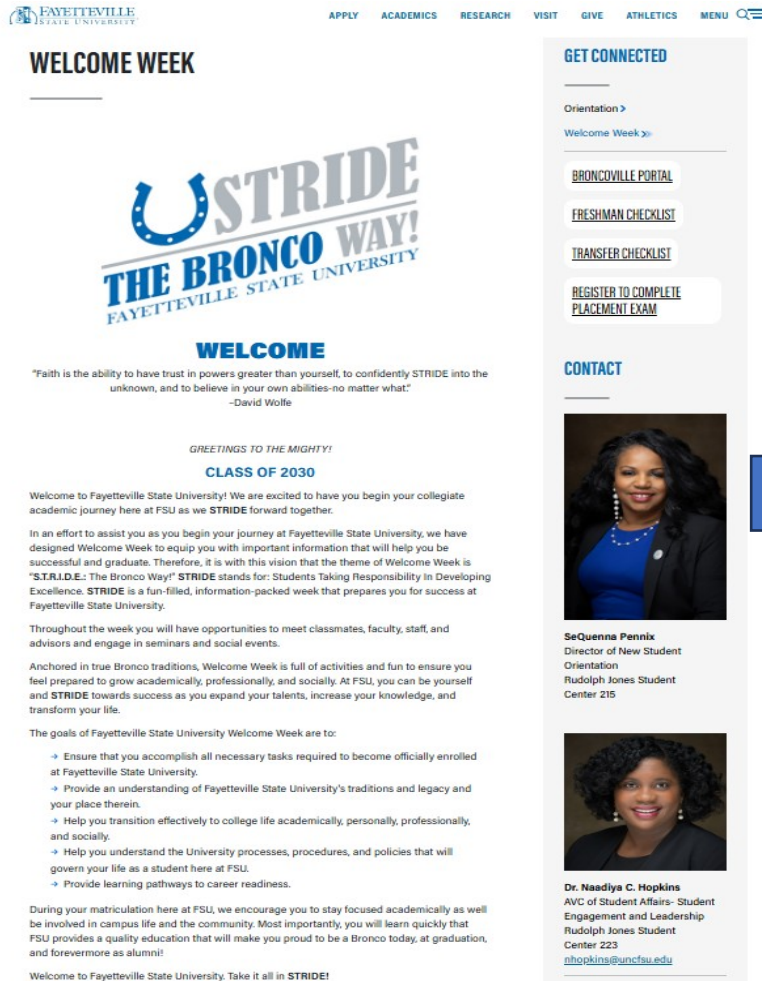

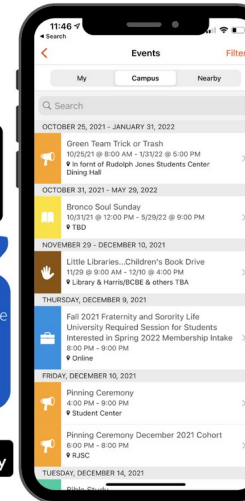
