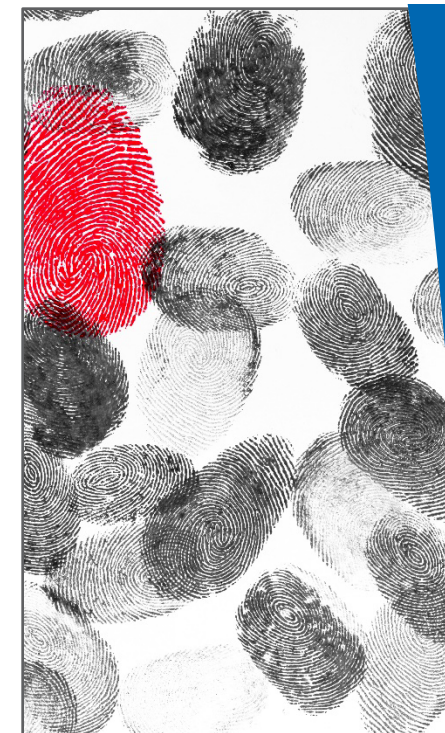

Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) Course

FOR HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS

Fayetteville State University, School of Nursing, Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) training will prepare health care professionals (HCPs) who are interested in learning more about forensic examinations of clients who experience violence or a sexual assault. HCPs will learn how to deliver trauma informed care, take a medical history for a sexual assault client, obtain consent, conduct a sexual assault physical examination, evidence collection, and how to provide testimony in court as part of the medical forensic exam and evidence collection. HCPs will also receive information on how to respond to and advocate for persons who suffer from violence and sexual assault.

ELIGIBLE HCPs INCLUDE:

WHAT IS THE COURSE COST?

THERE IS NO COST TO TAKE THIS COURSE.

WILL THERE BE OTHER ENROLLMENT DATES?

YES, COURSES WILL BE OFFERED EVERY FALL, SPRING, AND SUMMER SEMESTERS.

WHAT ARE COURSE REQUIREMENTS?

1 HOUR OF ONLINE PRECOURSE WORK IS REQUIRED FOR EACH SCHEDULED TRAINING. STUDENTS MUST ATTEND ALL DIDACTIC COURSES (VIRTUAL OR FACE-TO-FACE) AND CLINICAL PRACTICUM TRAINING ON SCHEDULED TRAINING DATES. COMPLETING DAILY AND FINAL COURSE EVALUATIONS.

WHAT ARE THE IAFN SANE CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS?

PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE A MINIMUM OF 16 CLINICAL PRACTICE HOURS THAT INCLUDE PERFORMING SEXUAL ASSAULT EXAMINATIONS WITH EVIDENCE COLLECTION AND DOCUMENTATION. ADDITIONALLY, PARTICIPANTS MUST COMPLETE 3 MEDICAL FORENSIC EXAMINATIONS WITH EVIDENCE COLLECTION USING A SEXUAL ASSAULT EVIDENCE COLLECTION KIT (SAEKI) AND HAVE SANE-A, SANE-P, OR SANE EXPERIENCED MEDICAL PROVIDER OVERSIGHT. PARTICIPANTS CANNOT PRACTICE AS A SANE IN NORTH CAROLINA UNTIL THESE REQUIREMENTS ARE MET.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT WHEN I'VE COMPLETED TRAINING?

UPON COMPLETION OF THEIR SANE TRAINING. PARTICIPANTS WILL HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO ENTER INTO A MENTORSHIP PROGRAM WITH THEIR SANE INSTRUCTOR. THIS PROGRAM IS DESIGNED TO SUPPORT THE NOVICE SANE NURSE DURING THEIR FIRST YEAR OF PRACTICE.
